Abstract

As a part of the organizational promotion of pharmaceutical medicine, The Japanese Association of Pharmaceutical Medicine (JAPhMed) has summarized the points to consider for ethical conduct of clinical research and presented them to the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW) in Jan. 2013. The aim was to restructure the integrity of clinical research in Japan by identifying various deficits in the current ethical principles and proposing its improvement.

By sharing our presented proposals, we hope all stakeholders will take positive actions to restore the credibility of clinical research funded by the industry.
