Standard of Practice for Statisticians: Recent activities by the Biometric Society of Japan

Abstract

In this paper, the author introduces the following two important revisions made by the Biometric Society of Japan (JBS) to the Standard of Practice for Statisticians: (1) Qualified bio-statisticians shall be responsible for the whole process of clinical research which they are involved in, and (2) Japan should establish social and educational systems to meet the needs of bio-statisticians to effectively carry out their activities.

In December 2013, JBS also revised its ethical standards for biostatisticians to clarify the general principles of practices for the statisticians, as well as for students who may become qualified statisticians, and for those who interact with activities of statisticians.
