Conep/CEP System

National Health Council (CNS)





Guaranteed by the 1988 Brazilian Federal Constitution

The CNS created the National Research Ethics Commission (CONEP) by Resolution 196/1996, succeeded by Resolutions 466/2012, which established regional research ethics committees (CEPs). This CEP/CONEP System is responsible for the ethical supervision of all research projects involving human subjects in Brazil

The CNS composition

- 48 members, and their respective first and second alternates
- National bodies of health professionals/health sector scientific community
- National entities of health service providers
- National entities with activities in the area of health
- Federal government representatives
- Entities and Social Movements using the Unified Health System (SUS)

In order to maintain the balance of interests of the entities involved, the composition of the CNS is made up of:

- 50% of users of the Unified Health System(SUS)
- 25% of workers
- 25% of service providers and managers

CEP/Conep System



NATIONAL RESEARCH ETHICS COMMISSION (CONEP) (established by Resolution CNS 196/1996)

Collegiate body, normative, deliberative, regulatory, advisory, educational and formulator of guidelines for ethics in research with human beings

Analyzes the ethical aspects of research with human beings, its adequacy and regulatory updating, monitoring and monitoring of compliance

Managed by the National Health Council/CNS/MS and the Secretariat of Science and Technology, Innovation and Health Complex – SECTICS of the Ministry of Health (Res CNS 446/2012)

Approves the existence and supervises 898 research ethics committees

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
CONEP Composition





Other risk of the law:

- established outside of social control, with increased risks of conflicts of interests
- Limitations on the right to post-study access to medication/treatment
- More flexible standards for sending biological material outside the country
